



VCAL Pathway Data from 2015 Enrolments

The pathway data from the 30 students who commenced either VCAL Intermediate or Senior in 2015 with PCLC shows that there was a 6.6% successful completion rate. 20% of students either withdrew or did not complete their course successfully. 4 students successfully secured employment, 3 students went onto to further study and 9 students will return to study at PCLC in 2016 to complete their VCAL.

As at February 2016 students enrolled in 2015, 43.3% have moved on to further study either with PCLC, mainstream secondary or with another TAFE or RTO. This shows that 56.6% of these students are currently employed or studying. Of the 56.6% of students who have gone on to further study 30% are enrolled in courses with PCLC.
